Report March 2012

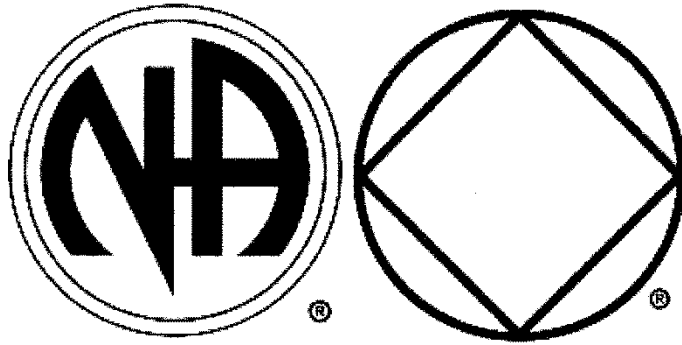
