Article I

Name:

The name of this Subcommittee shall be Space Coast Area Literature Subcommittee.

Article II

Purpose and Definition

Definition:

The S.C.A.L.C. exists to encourage the involvement of all members of Space Coast Area Narcotics Anonymous in all facets of writing, reviewing, and approving Narcotics Anonymous Literature. It is here that N.A. members develop new literature, make input to review from drafts, and evaluate approval from drafts. This is an opportunity for N.A. members to critique and improve N.A. literature that is out to the fellowship for review and input. Through participation in literature committee forums and workshops, all members are encouraged to make suggestions for additions and deletions, and write original material which they feel will improve the draft. The responsibility for reviewing and making input to literature rests with the member.

Purpose:

1. To maintain an adequate supply of Narcotics Anonymous Literature to meet the needs of the Local Fellowship; to stock and make available review and approval from literature.
2. To serve as a communication link in all matters of literature between the Group and Literature committees on all levels – Area, Region, and world.
3. To distribute N.A. Literature in the Space Coast Area in approved organized, efficient manner.
4. To provide the forum and atmosphere where members may contribute to the development and creation of N.A. literature.
5. To carry the written message of recovery to the still suffering addict.

Article III

Members:

1. Specific membership in this Subcommittee shall consist of the Literature Chairperson, the Literature Vice-Chair, Space Coast Area Treasurer, and the Secretary. These are Elected Servants of the Subcommittee.
2. General membership in this committee is open to all N.A. members and they are welcome and encouraged to share their experience and understanding in written form. The way to participate is too become an active member in the literature committee. Any member may become a member at large by attending two consecutive literature committee meetings. One becomes a voting member at the second consecutive meeting. For members at large, the

- first unexcused absence constitutes resignation from the committee. To be excused simply notify any elected servant of this committee prior to the meeting to be missed.
3. Committee meeting and workshops are open to any N.A. member, and anyone present may participate in discussion.

Article IV

Elected Servants:

a. Chairperson

Elected by the SCASC pursuant to Area Guidelines. The Chairperson is responsible for communicating with other Trusted Servants and Members of the committee to ensure continuity of effort. The Chairperson sets up regular meetings, including times, dates, and locations, and directs the focus of the meeting. In addition, the Chairperson is responsible for making regular reports to the appropriate service committee, (Area or Regional) and serving as a liaison between the WSC Literature Committee and the members of the Area or Region. The Chairperson of an Area Literature Committee is encouraged to participate in the Regional Literature Committee.

1. Term of service is for 1 year.
2. Minimum clean time is one year.
